Finance for Non-Financial Professionals

Welcome, overview and introduction to the programme

10:00 – 11:15 Understanding finance speak

- De-mystifying jargon and understanding the relevance of terminology

Exploring the different financial reports and their usefulness

The first session of the day will help delegates to learn the regular financial terminology used in organisations to become comfortable with commonly used jargon. Time is then spent looking at the financial reports that could be helpful in their role.

- An appreciation of costing to forecast meaningful budgets
- Financial ratios to analyse business performance

 Introduction and explanation of cash flow, the balance sheet, and profit and loss statement

Delegates will uncover how different costs are treated to enable accurate budgeting. We then explore the impact of effective budgeting and key financial ratios on business planning. Finally, delegates are introduced to three main financial reports they may want to have sight of.

The Financial Challenge – running a business and accounting accurately

• Profit and Loss and Balance Sheet

During this session delegates will work together on a business scenario to understand how the accounting of daily transactions works and the importance of accurate documentation. They will complete key documentation to demonstrate business health.

- How accurate accounting informs daily financial business decisions

The final session of the day asks delegates to debate key financial decisions and examine accounts for insight. We then explore the relationship between different numbers and how they can influence decision-making, efficiencies, and effectiveness. The day concludes with everybody exploring their own learning and action plans.
